## "Invest in Restoration of Habitat" Thumb Area Branch of QDMA's Habitat Cost Share Program

With the declining numbers of wooded land from fence rows being taken down, entire woods being harvested in place of farm land or the construction of more industry, our natural habitat is not what it once was.

The Thumb Area Branch of QDMA is pleased to announce a continued benefit available exclusively to QDMA members [if you are not one, become one by calling (800) 209-3337] interested in a limited cost share for selected habitat projects in Huron, Sanilac and/or Tuscola County(ies). The Thumb Area Branch of QDMA has again agreed to provide a total of \$5,000 for this year's program, with no more than \$150 going to any one Applicant and/or Property.

Requirements include:

1. Cost share will only apply to purchase(s) (including related sales tax and handling fee) made in the spring of 2018 from the Conservation District(s) in Huron, Sanilac and/or Tuscola County(ies) of trees, shrubs, plants, grasses and/or related protective items (e.g., tree guards and/or mats) and/or seeds (collectively referred to herein as "Qualified Purchases");

2. Qualified Purchases must be properly planted and/or properly utilized (as the case may be, and are collectively referred to as "Plantings") in Huron, Sanilac and/or Tuscola County(ies) the spring of 2018 and on or before May 5, 2018;

3. The person making the application ("Applicant") **must be (or become) a QDMA member** during relative time periods (e.g., as of the time of all Qualified Purchases, all Plantings, Application, Payment, etc.);

4. All Plantings must be on real estate owned, directly or indirectly, by Applicant ("Property") in such a manner that Applicant can, and does, grant select representatives of the Thumb Area Branch of QDMA legal permission to enter onto the Property, with the Applicant on a mutually agreeable date and time (on or before August 31, 2018), to inspect, and to take pictures for publication of, the Plantings and Property; and

5. Application, with all required supporting documentation, proving that all of these requirements have been satisfied (e.g., proof of payment for the Qualified Purchases, etc.), must be timely submitted by email to <u>thumbareaqdma@gmail.com</u> as soon as possible but in no event after May 5, 2018. The Application form follows.

After inspection of the Plantings of an acceptable Application, the approved Applicant will receive a Thumb Area Branch of QDMA check for up to one half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the price of the Qualified Purchases up to a total of \$300.00 of Qualified Purchases. Accordingly, the maximum Thumb Area Branch of QDMA check would be \$150.00, which equals one half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of \$300.00. Again the maximum match is \$150 per Applicant (and/or Property); accordingly, if Qualified Purchases are \$80, Applicant could receive no more than \$40. If the Qualified Purchases totaled \$400, the Applicant could receive no more than \$150. Please note that if there are too many Applications, then the limited funds may be paid out on a first in time basis of those Applicants who have satisfied all of the requirements as determined by the Thumb Area Branch of QDMA in its sole and absolute unfettered discretion.
