Envirothon is an academic, team-based environmental education program designed for high school students (grades 9–12). It combines classroom learning with hands-on, outdoor experiences to engage students in the study of natural resources, ecology, and environmental science.

Through the program, students explore five key topics:

- Soils and Land Use
- Aquatic Ecology
- Forestry
- Wildlife
- Current Environmental Issues (which change annually)

Working in teams, students develop critical thinking, public speaking, and leadership skills as they prepare to compete in regional and state-level events. The winning team from Michigan advances to represent the state at the National Conservation Foundation's Envirothon, a week-long international competition.
